WHAT IS GERONTOLOGY?

Gerontology is the study of longevity. Students of gerontology study not only physiological changes that occur with aging, but also social roles, normative expectations, attitudes and beliefs, stereotypes, and policy, health and economic issues which define the aging experience.

HOW DOES GERONTOLOGY COMPLEMENT MY EXERCISE SCIENCE DEGREE?

It would be beneficial to consider adding the Gerontology Minor to your BS in Exercise Science or Certificate in Gerontology to the MA in Kinesiology. For the BS in Exercise Science, you know the impact of regular exercise in early and middle adulthood certainly impacts one's health later in life. Gaining more insight into the common issues that involve older adults allows you to more effectively work to provide exercise instruction for this population. For MS in Kinesiology students, the development of late-life chronic diseases in common with aging, and many individuals can be aided with the incorporation of exercise programming. Gaining additional course content in Gerontology expands your area of knowledge and greatly improves your ability to work with the growing older adult population as they seek our your expertise.
